Job Title: Work Related Learning Adviser

## Job Purpose:

Our Work-Related Learning (WRL) department are responsible for commercial contracts delivering employer related services to educational establishments. The WRL Adviser will work with the Operations Manager to administer, carry out and develop work related learning services including the project management and delivery of individual contracts, marketing development, contributing to the development of operational plans.

## **Job Objectives:**

- 1. Develop new business in line with target requirements (each Adviser has a percentage of department target).
- 2. Project manage multiple school projects/contracts to successfully source, match and place students in accordance with agreed service delivery plan.
- 3. Engagement with Education Institutions and support for careers leaders and teachers.
- 4. Administer and update database to ensure student/employer records are accurate.
- 5. Prepare employers to provide inclusive work experiencee placements and undertake health and safety checks, risk assessment and suitability of placements for young people.
- 6. Provide planned activities against the delivery plan, including preparing individual students for work experience placements and preparing and delivering briefing sessions for students and teachers.





- 7. Produce impact reports at end of each project and provide recommendations for schools.
- 8. Directly engage with employers and schools to promote the work related learning service.
- 9. Prepare and deliver briefing sessions for employers and students.
- 10. Adhere to WRL Quality Framework and Programme Guidance striving for continuous improvement in service delivery.
- 11. Be responsible for adhering to both local and corporate safeguarding policy and procedures aimed at promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and at-risk adults and attend mandatory child protection and/or adult protection safeguarding and Prevent training.
